

SMELLING BOTTLES

Instructions:

- **1.** Select 8 identical glass bottles, each with a flip top or top with holes in the lid.
- 2. Fill the bottles with 4 extracts, spices, herbs, seasonings, etc. such as lavender, cinnamon, eucalyptus, cloves, etc. There should be 2 bottles with each scent in them when you are finished. **It is important to mention if you are using clear bottles to use cotton balls and extracts, but if you use colored bottles, you can use herbs, spices, or other food items as your scents.
- **3.** Label the bottles with two sets of symbols such as red stars and blue stars, to indicate to the child the 2 sets. For instance, one bottle with lavender would have a red star and one bottle with lavender would have a blue star.
- **4.** Creating a control of error by subtly marking the bottoms of the bottles can be helpful for your child and for you to later check their work. For instance, each bottle with cloves would have 1 dot on the bottom of the jar and each bottle with cinnamon would have 2 dots on the bottom.

*Note: This same activity can be modified to create Tasting Bottles with various drinks and Sound Cylinders with concealed containers and various materials to create different sounds.
